The City of Annapolis is amending its FY 2010 Action Plan by allocating \$52,750 in unexpended Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the Housing Rehabilitation Program to defray the cost of program administration. By federal statute, the City is allowed to use up to 20% of its CDBG funds for general administrative costs.

This change in use of these funds requires a substantial amendment to the City's FY 2010 Housing and Community Development Action Plan. This Plan, which was previously approved by HUD, governs the City's use of its federal community development and housing funds.

The amendment to the FY 2010 Action Plan is available for review and comment by the public from March 4, 2010 through April 4, 2010 at the Community Development Office (third floor), Planning and Zoning Department, 145 Gorman Street, Annapolis, MD 21401 and on the City's web site <http://annapolis.gov>.
