Memorial Tree Program

The Memorial Tree Program allows you to dedicate a young tree to honor the birth of a child, express sympathy or honor a friend or relative who has passed away.



Truxtun Park

Trees in parks help reduce air and noise pollution and increase the real estate value of surrounding neighborhoods. This is a great way to memorialize an individual and enhance our local environment.

The memorial tree will be planted in a park or open space within the City of Annapolis. Tree species, location and planting will be determined and accomplished by the Annapolis Recreation and Parks Department. Trees are planted during the fall and spring planting seasons, but they may be ordered at any time.

If the donor wishes, a card of acknowledgment will be sent to the recipient's family advising that their loved one has been memorialized or honored in this special way. A picture of the planted tree and a description of its location will be

included. As an option, the name of the loved one memorialized or honored will be inscribed on a brass leaf plaque on the Memorial Tree display located in the main hallway at the "Pip" Moyer Recreation Center.

Memorial Bench Program

Memorial benches have become an increasingly popular way to remember and pay tribute to loved ones. The Memorial Bench Program allows you to dedicate a park bench to be placed in a park or open space area within the City of Annapolis.

You will work closely with the Annapolis Recreation and Parks Department staff to determine the ideal location for your bench. Benches take approximately two months to be delivered and installed.

If the donor wishes, a card of acknowledgment will be sent to the recipient's family advising that their loved one has been memorialized or honored in this special way. A picture of the bench and a description of its location will be included. As an option, the name of the loved one memorialized or honored will be inscribed on a plaque to be placed on the park bench.
