Staff Present. Chief Pristoop, Captain Amoia, Deputy Chief Simmons, HR Director Rensted.

- **Alderman Kirby moved to approve of minutes of May 15, 2013. Seconded. CARRIED on voice vote**

Chief Pristoop discussed changes in the APD organizational charts. (Attached)

Chief Pristoop offered an update on crime.

Chief Pristoop discussed Taser legality in Annapolis. The Chief stated that the City does have a law not allowing Tasers. In the county now Tasers are allowed but in the city only Police officers and Active Duty Military can carry Tasers.

11.44.070 - Electronic weapons.

A. In this section, "electronic weapon" means a "stun gun" or any similar device, by whatever name, that is designed as a weapon capable of injuring any individual by the discharge of electrical current.

B. Except as otherwise provided in this Section, no person shall possess, deliver, receive, or discharge any electronic weapon.

C. This Section shall not apply to any law enforcement officer or member of the Armed Forces authorized to possess an electronic weapon while on duty in the performance of official authorized functions.

Captain Amoia discussed crime analysis in the City of Annapolis.

Deputy Chief Simmons discussed Emergency Medical Training week and the employee training on CPR.

Ms. Schultz offered an updated review of the Heat Plan.

Captain Bowes discussed the officer development program.

The committee discussed O-20-13 Highly Compensated Employees in the Police and Fire Retirement Plan.
