

Daily Report 06/11/14

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 118 calls for service and arrested 17 people.

Good News – On 06/09 Christopher Jameson, 24, of Edgewater was arrested and charged with stealing a battery from a business and throwing a concrete brick at the business owner. This incident occurred on 12/04/13 in the 1800 block of George Av. Through investigation detectives were able to identify Jameson as the suspect. Jameson was charged with robbery, second degree assault, reckless endangerment, and five additional charges. Jameson was released from the Jennifer Road Detention Center after posting \$15,000 bond.

Burglary – 201400002877 – 1000 block of Cedar Ridge Ct – 06/08 at 11am to 06/09 at 8am: Money was stolen from a home after an interior bedroom door was forced open. There was no sign of forced entry to the exterior of the home.

Theft from Vehicle – 201400002902 – Unit block of Wardour Dr – 06/09 at 9pm to 06/10 at 10am: A citizen reported an abandoned blue backpack near Kent Rd. The backpack was stolen from an apparently unlocked vehicle on Wardour Dr. The owner was not aware of the theft until the officer returned the backpack.

Theft from Vehicle – 201400002911 – 200 block of Westwood Rd – 06/09 at 7:30pm to 06/10 at 6am: A small red coin purse containing money was stolen from an unlocked vehicle.
