

Daily Report 06/16/14

In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 317 calls for service and arrested 23 people.

Burglary – 201400002962 – 700 block of Newtowne Dr – 06/13 at 8:30pm: Officers responded to the 1300 block of Tyler Av for a report of a possible shooting. Information from callers indicated a possible suspect or victim in the shooting was leaving in a maroon Cadillac. Officers located a maroon Cadillac turning onto Forest Dr and attempted to stop it. The driver of the Cadillac, later identified as Christopher Wills, 20, of Upper Marlboro, did not stop for the officers. Wills drove into the 700 block of Newtowne Dr where he drove off road to avoid officers. Wills ran out of the car and forced his way into an apartment where officers arrested him. Wills was charged with first, second, third, and fourth degree burglary, trespass, destruction of property, and numerous traffic offenses. He is being held on \$50,000 bond at the Jennifer Road Detention Center.

Burglary – 201400002969 – 900 block of Madison St – 06/14 at 1am: Officers responded to the area for a report of a man pulling flowers from a flower bed. The caller saw the man walk over to vacant property and then heard what sounded like glass breaking. Officers checked the vacant home and found the front window broken. Officers located the suspect, Jose Vasquez Reyes, 26, of Annapolis, who admitted to breaking the window and entering the vacant home. Vasquez Reyes was charged with fourth degree burglary and destruction of property. He was released by the District Court Commissioner.

Stolen Motorcycle – 201400002972 – 1000 block of Spa Rd – 06/14 from 2am to 8am: A black and silver 2007 Honda CBR600, MD reg. 17238Y, with red tipped handle bars and a Jardine custom exhaust was stolen from the parking lot.

Theft of Bicycle – 201400002975 – Unit block of Hill St – 06/13 at 8:30pm to 06/14 at 8am: A boy's bicycle was stolen from an open garage. Officers located the bicycle being ridden by a 13 year old boy from Annapolis. It was returned to the owner and the 13 year old boy was charged with its theft.

Stabbing – 201400003004 – 700 block of Newtowne Dr – 06/16 at 12:10am: Brandon Hardy, 17, of Annapolis was arrested and charged as an adult after stabbing another 17 year old in the chest. The victim was transported to Baltimore Shock Trauma and was in stable condition. Hardy was charged with attempted first degree murder, first and second degree assault, reckless endangerment, and possession of a dangerous weapon with intent to injure. Hardy is being held without bond at the Jennifer Road Detention Center.
