## **Annapolis Police Department Investigates Fatal Accident**

Officers from the Annapolis Police Department Traffic Safety Unit are investigating a fatal traffic accident involving a pedestrian.

At 8:31 a.m. officers responded to a pedestrian struck near the Maryland Fire-Rescue Services Memorial located at Bladen Street and Calvert Street. A blue pick up truck being driven by a 22 year old man was traveling southeast on Rowe Boulevard approaching the intersection with Calvert Street when the driver left the roadway to the right, mounted the curb, and struck a 39 years old man on foot working for a landscaping company. The man was transported to Anne Arundel Medical Center and later died from his injuries. The driver remained on the scene and assisted us with the investigation.

The investigation into the accident is ongoing. Police are not releasing information on the vehicle or identity of the driver or pedestrian at this time.

The preliminary cause of the crash is the driver's failure to remain on the roadway. Alcohol does not appear to be a factor in the crash.
