## Community Events

**In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 82 calls for service and arrested 5 people.**

**Shooting** – 201500005771 – Calvert St at Northwest St – 12/17 at 8:30pm: At 8:43pm officers responded to Anne Arundel Medical Center for an adult male suffering from gunshot wounds to his arm. The victim reported that he was walking in the area when a blue newer model Honda Civic with two men inside stopped beside him. One of the men exited the vehicle holding a handgun. The victim fled the area on foot, but the suspect shot at him, striking him in the arm three times. The victim ran to West Washington Street and was driven to AAMC by a friend. The victim’s wounds were non-life threatening.
