January 5 – Auxiliary Officer Open House from 6:30pm to 8pm at 199 Taylor Avenue

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 77 calls for service and arrested 12 people.

Shots Fired – 201500005930 – 900 block of Royal St – 12/30 at 8:20pm: Officers responded to the area for reports of shots fired and located shell casings and a bullet fragment. No victims or suspects were located and no property appeared to have been damaged.

Burglary – 201500005932 – 1500 block of Ritchie La – 12/30 from 8:30pm to 9pm: Officers responded to an intrusion alarm at the home and found the side door forced open. The home was entered, but nothing was stolen.

Robbery – 201500005936 – 700 block of Newtowne Dr – 12/31 at 1:30am: The adult female victim was assaulted by the father of her child after a verbal argument. During the assault the suspect took money out of the victim's clothing. The suspect fled after taking the money.
