## Community Events:

August 22 – Coffee with a Cop from 8am to 10am at Safeway at 1781 Forest Dr

**In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 119 calls for service and arrested 9 people.**

Victim followed suspect out of business and confronted him when the suspected then punched him in the face. Suspect then fled on foot. Suspect has been located and placed under arrest.
