In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 122 calls for service and arrested 25 people.

Good News – On December 8th Alfred Sugg, 20, of Shady Side was charged with the robbery that occurred on 12/02 in the 1900 block of Fairfax Rd. On 12/02 at 8:45am the adult male victim was standing in line to make a purchase when Sugg came up behind him and grabbed money out of his hands. Detectives were able to identify Sugg as the suspect and charged him with robbery, second degree assault, theft less than \$100 and attempted theft less than \$100. Sugg is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center on \$25,000 bond on these charges.

Theft from Vehicle – 201500005629 – 800 block of Chester Av – 12/07 at 10:30pm to 12/08 at 5:50am: A soft top Jeep was forced open and money was stolen.

Burglary – 201500005640 – 200 block of Farragut Ct – 12/08 from 10am to 2:30pm: An apartment was entered, but nothing was stolen from inside.

Package Theft – 201500005641 – 1000 block of Spa Rd – 12/04 from 7am to 7pm: A UPS package was delivered to an apartment door, but stolen before the recipient retrieved it.
