

Daily Report 07/01/15

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 108 calls for service and arrested 15 people.

Good News – On 06/30 Akeem Howard, 20, of Annapolis was arrested and charged with the robbery that occurred on 06/29 at 10:50pm on Brashears St near Monroe St. Two men were walking in the area when four suspects assaulted them and stole property from them. One 16 year old male suspect was arrested on 06/29, directly after the robbery. The juvenile was charged and transported to Cheltenham Youth Facility. Akeem Howard was identified as another suspect in the robbery and was charged with robbery, assault, theft, and reckless endangerment. He is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center on \$100,000 bond.

Theft from Vehicle – 201500002827 – Unit block of Windwhisper La – 06/28 to 06/29: On 06/29 at 8:37pm a resident reported property abandoned in the area of the 900 block of Windwhisper La. After making contact with the property's owner it was discovered the property was stolen from a vehicle parked in the unit block of Windwhisper La.

Theft from Vehicle – 201500002836 – 1700 block of West St – 06/11 at 12:01pm to 06/30 at 1:15pm: A catalytic converter was cut off a vehicle parked in the lot.

Burglary – 201500002838 – 1400 block of Hunting Wood Rd – 06/26 at 1pm to 06/29 at 10:20pm: The door to the rear screened in porch was forced open, but the rest of the home was not entered and no property was stolen.

Attempted Burglary – 201500002842 – 1400 block of Hunting Wood Rd – 06/29 at 11:30pm to 06/30 at 6am: Several window screens were cut and removed, but all the windows were locked and no entry was made into the home.

Stabbing – 201500002843 – 300 block of Garden Gate La – 06/30 at 7:19pm: The adult male victim and Delante Smith, 29, of Annapolis were involved in an altercation outside of their homes. The victim was stabbed in the chest by Smith during the altercation. The victim was transported to Baltimore Shock Trauma and his injuries are believed to be non-life threatening. Smith was charged with assault and reckless endangerment and is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center without bond.

Burglary – 201500002846 – Unit block of Skippers Ct – 06/30 from 2pm to 11:30pm: An unlocked window was entered and an Apple MacBook laptop computer in a pink case, a black Panasonic digital camera, and jewelry were stolen from the home.
