

Daily Report 07/21/15

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 97 calls for service and arrested 8 people.

Attempted Armed Robbery – 201500003197 – 1000 block of Eaglewood Rd – 07/18 at 11:57pm: The adult male victim reported he was walking in the area when a man called him over to a vehicle. While the victim was walking towards the vehicle two other men got out of it and told him to “drop what you got”. One of the men displayed a handgun. When the victim started putting his hand in his pocket one of the men struck him in the face. The victim heard a loud pop and believes the handgun discharged. The victim ran and the suspects fled the area in a vehicle. The victim called the police and provided a description of the vehicle. Officers responding to the robbery located the vehicle and stopped it in the 900 block of Bay Ridge Rd. Inside the vehicle were the three suspects who were identified by the victim. The suspects were identified as Adir Mahmutagic, 22, Damir Mahmutagic, 19, and Matthew Colon Mejias, 17, all three are from Bowie. Adir and Damir Mahmutagic were charged with eleven criminal counts, including armed robbery, robbery, use of a firearm in a felony or violent crime, and possession of marijuana. Both are being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center on \$500,000 bond. Matthew Colon Mejias was charged as an adult with thirteen criminal counts and is being held without bond.
