In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 120 calls for service and arrested 7 people.

Update to Burglary – 201500003321 – 700 block of Drake Way – 07/25 from 1:45pm to 2pm: A red Schwinn bicycle was stolen from an open garage. Deangelo Blake, 21, of Annapolis was identified as the suspect in this case. A criminal summons for Blake was issued by the District Court Commissioner for fourth degree burglary and two counts of theft. Blake was served with the summons on 07/30.

Stolen and Recovered Motorcycle – 201500003418 – 1200 block of Ashton Ct – 07/30 between 12:01pm and 7pm: An officer responded to the 2000 block of Bay Ridge Av for a report of an abandoned Suzuki motorcycle. The officer made contact with the owner and discovered that the motorcycle had been stolen. The owner was unaware the motorcycle was stolen until contacted by the officer. The motorcycle's ignition was damaged.
