June 9 – Neighborhood Watch Meeting from 6:30pm to 8pm at 199 Taylor Av

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 84 calls for service and arrested 6 people.

Burglary – 201500002217 – 100 block of Granville Av – 05/27 at 11pm to 05/28 at 11:30am: Two black and orange Worx battery powered grass trimmers were stolen from an unlocked detached garage.

Burglary – 201500002323 – 700 block of Glenwood St – 06/02 from 7:45am to 4:30pm: The home was entered through an apparently unlocked window and a Nintendo Wii game console, a Nintendo DS handheld game console and games, a Sony Playstation 3 game console and game, money, and car keys were stolen.

Burglary – 201500002327 – Unit block of Silopanna Rd – 06/01 at 8:45am to 06/02 at 8pm: The home was entered through an unlocked rear door and clothing, a green metal cash box, a stainless steel Tag Heuer wristwatch with a dark grey face, cuff links, and coins were stolen.

Lock Your Block

One of the easiest ways to become a victim is to leave your car and home unlocked. Please help Annapolis Police Department prevent thefts in your neighborhood by making sure your block is locked. Take the time to lock your vehicle and remove valuable items. When you leave your home double check the door and make sure all windows are closed and locked. Report suspicious activity to police by calling [410-268-4141](tel:410-268-4141) or, in an emergency, dial 911. If you are a victim of a crime report it to police quickly and provide officers with descriptions and/or serial numbers of the items taken.
