## Community Events

**In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 97 calls for service and arrested 11 people.**

**Recovered Stolen Vehicle** – 201500002038 – 1100 block of Bay Ridge Av – 06/04 at 2:29pm: The 1996 Ford Windstar reported stolen from McKinley St in May was recovered parked and unoccupied.

**Theft from Vehicle** – 201500002341 – Unit block of Ashford Ct – 06/03 at 9pm to 06/04 at 12:04pm: Money was stolen from an unlocked vehicle.

**Attempted Theft from Vehicle** – 201500002342 – 1400 block of Hunting Wood Rd – 06/03 at 7pm to 06/04 at 8am: An apparently unlocked vehicle was entered, but nothing was stolen.

**Shots Fired** – 201500002351 – Unit block of Juliana Circle – 06/04 at 6:15pm: Officers responded to the area for reports of shots fired. Officers discovered that two adult victims were in a moving vehicle when a suspect in an unknown vehicle shot at and struck the victims' vehicle. The victim driver then backed up and struck a third vehicle. The suspect vehicle fled the area before officers arrived. Officers located the victims' vehicle and the vehicle struck by the victims' vehicle in the 800 block of Betsy Ct.

**Theft** – 201500002354 – Unit block of Rosemary St – 06/02 at 7:07pm: A UPS package was stolen from the front porch after it was delivered to the home.

**Attempted Burglary** – 201500002355 – Unit block of German St – 06/05 at 12:07am: The residents heard someone attempting to open the front door to the home and called the police. Officers checked the area, but did not locate a suspect.

On 06/04 several destructions of property to vehicles were reported. Damage included broken windows and windshields. These crimes were reported on Silopanna Rd, Annapolitan La, Melrob Ct, Woods Dr, and Rosewood St.
