Community Events

December 3, 10, and 17 – CoCo with the PoPo from 7pm to 9pm outside 220 Main St - Enjoy a free cup of hot chocolate with your local police officers.

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 112 calls for service and arrested 14 people.

Thefts from Vehicles – 201500005433 – King George St near College Av – 11/24 from 8:30am to 1pm: The windows of two vehicles parked in the area were smashed and GPS units were stolen. Officers arrested Darrell Collins, 53, of Annapolis at 1:35pm for an open warrant and he was carrying a backpack containing GPS units. Two GPS units were the ones stolen from the two vehicles on King George St. Collins was charged with two counts of theft, two counts of rogue and vagabond, and two counts of destruction of property.
