Community Events

October 30 – Coffee with a Cop from 8am to 10am at the City Dock Café at 18 Market Space

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 109 calls for service and arrested 10 people.

Good News – On the evening of 10/22 our detectives arrested Daniel Rivera, 56, of Annapolis for the rape of a 12 year old girl and sexual assault of a 10 year old girl. Rivera was charged with 26 criminal counts relating to these assaults. Detectives located Rivera in Baltimore late last night, arrested him, and transported him back to Annapolis. Rivera is currently being held on \$500,000 at the Jennifer Road Detention Center.

Robbery – 201500004875 – 1000 block of Van Buren St – 10/21 at 2:25pm: The 17 year old male victim reported he got off the school bus and was surrounded by six juvenile male suspects who got off the same bus. One of the juveniles grabbed the victim and the others took a wallet from the victim's pocket. The victim was pushed to the ground and struck his head on a parked vehicle. The suspects then fled the area. The victim was transported to Anne Arundel Medical Center with minor injuries.

Burglary – 201500004906 – 1100 block of President St – 10/22 at 8:10pm: The adult male resident was sitting in the living room when he heard someone entering his home through an unlocked rear door. The resident then saw a man he didn't know walk into the living room. The suspect saw the resident and walked through the home and out the front door. The resident checked the area near the rear door and found that a set of keys was stolen. The suspect is described as an African American man, 5'10" to 6'0" tall, with a heavy build, he was last seen wearing a red hat, black t-shirt, and green "Army style" pants. The suspect matches the description of a man who stole a bottle of liquor from a store in the 1000 block of Bay Ridge Av earlier the same evening.
