Annapolis Police Department has a permanent prescription drug drop off box in the lobby of police headquarters, 199 Taylor Avenue. The public can discard expired, unwanted, and unused prescription and over-the-counter drugs Monday through Friday, 8am to 4pm, excluding holidays. Liquid products, intravenous solutions, needles and syringes, and illicit substances should not be dropped in the box.
