Community Events

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 97 calls for service and arrested 8 people.

Vehicle Theft – 201500004384 – 200 block of Boxwood Rd – 09/21 at 7:30pm to 09/22 at 6am: A tan 1995 Toyota Corolla four door sedan, MD reg. 5EFN13, was stolen from the parking lot.

Theft from Vehicle – 201500004387 – 500 block of Burnside St – 09/21 at 10:30pm to 09/22 at 4am: The rear passenger side window to the vehicle was shattered and an Apple MacBook Pro laptop in a black case, exterior residential lights, a toolbox with masonry tools inside, two DeWalt hammer drills, two DeWalt batteries, two drill bit sets, and a wallet were stolen.

Burglary – 201500004391 – 700 block of Chesapeake Av – 09/21 at 5pm to 09/22 at 3pm: The rear door to the home was forced open and liquor, a DeWalt electric drill, a heat gun, an electric hand sander, and other hand tools were stolen.

Theft from Vehicle – 201500004396 – 200 block of Old Solomons Island Rd – 09/20 to 09/22 at 7pm: Money and a Bluetooth device were stolen from an apparently unlocked vehicle.

Armed Robbery – 201500004401 – 1100 block of Frederick Douglass St – 09/22 at 8:40pm: At 10:20pm officers responded to Anne Arundel Medical Center for a report of an armed robbery that occurred earlier. Officers spoke to the adult male victim who reported that he was walking in the 1100 block of Frederick Douglass St when he saw several adult male suspects, some he recently met. When the victim got close to the men one of them grabbed him around the neck and another displayed a handgun and struck the victim in the face. They took the victim's wallet and his shoes, kicked him in the ribs and fled the area. The victim became unconscious and when he came to he walked to an apartment in the area and then went to the hospital for treatment.

Attempted Theft from Vehicle – 201500004403 – 800 block of Chester Av – 09/23 at 2:40am: The vehicle operator returned to the parked, apparently unlocked, vehicle and discovered the rear hatch open and a man looking inside. She asked the man what he was doing and he replied that he was looking for a place to sleep and walked away. It is unknown if anything was stolen from the vehicle.
