## Community Events

**In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 87 calls for service and arrested 7 people.**

## Fraudulent Utility Worker Alert

On 09/29 a man identifying himself as an employee of BGE gained entry to a home in the 1800 block of Schooner Ct. He appeared to tamper with the home's electric meter outside and then asked to come inside and use the bathroom. When the resident asked for identification from the man he could not provide any. The resident contacted BGE and they instructed her to call the police. The man is described as an African American male, 6'0" with a thin build and a thin mustache and goatee, he was wearing a white hard hat with BGE on it and a neon yellow reflective vest. He was last seen driving a white Toyota pick up truck with Texas registration plates and the words Grid One Solutions written on the side. Remember – never open your door to someone you don't recognize, ask for a photo ID through the door window, all BGE employees and contractors carry ID badges. To verify a BGE employee's identity or work being done call BGE at 1-800-685-0123. Call the Annapolis Police Department to report any suspicious activity at 410-268-4141 or 9-1-1 in an emergency.
