

Daily Report 05/21/15

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 87 calls for service and arrested 6 people.

Good News – On 05/21 a missing 10 year old boy was found thanks to an observant Facebook follower. On 05/20 at 11pm the 10 year was reported missing. Just after midnight the boy's photo was posted on the police department's Facebook page. A woman who saw the post had just seen the boy riding his bicycle downtown and called the police. Less than half an hour after the information was posted on Facebook the boy had been found.

Update to Armed Robbery – 201500002067 – 1900 block of Forest Dr – 05/20 at 1am: Three male suspects, at least one of whom displayed a gun, entered a business and ordered the employees to lie on the floor. The suspects took money from the register and fled the area in a vehicle. Officers located the vehicle on West St and when the driver did not stop, pursued the vehicle into Anne Arundel County. The suspects bailed out of the vehicle and fled on foot. Officers from the Annapolis Police Department with help from Anne Arundel County Police Department searched the area and located two suspects. The suspects have been transported to the Annapolis Police Department and charges are pending.

UPDATE – It was determined that three suspects went into the business and one suspect waited in the getaway car. After the driver fled from the police and all four suspects bailed out of the vehicle, two suspects were located in the area and arrested. The other two suspects were located much later and arrested. A handgun was also recovered after it was thrown from the vehicle during the chase. The four suspects were identified as Khaylan Makell, 18, and Tymar Wallace, 17, both of Severn and Jeremia Jefferson, 17, and Rodney Randall, 17, both of Glen Burnie. Wallace, Jefferson, and Randall were charged as adults. Makell was charged with 14 criminal counts related to armed robbery and is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center on \$100,000 bond. Jefferson was charged with 15 criminal counts related to armed robbery and is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center on \$100,000 bond. Wallace was charged with 15 criminal counts and is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center on a temporary commitment. Randall was charged with 15 criminal counts and posted \$100,000 bond and was released.

Stolen Vehicle – 201500002075 – 200 block of Pindell Av – 05/19 from 4pm to 7pm: A dark green 1996 Honda Accord, MD reg. 7BK1617, was stolen from outside a home.
