

Daily Report 05/27/15

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 119 calls for service and arrested 12 people.

Attempted Burglary – 201500002165 – 900 block of Windwhisper La – 05/25 from 3pm to 10pm: A screen to a rear window was cut, but the window was locked and the home was not entered.

Stolen Vehicle – 201500002184 – 500 block of Royal St – 05/23 at 4:30pm to 05/26 at 8:30pm: A silver 2003 Chrysler Town and Country minivan, MD reg. 65172CE, was stolen from a parking spot on the street.

Burglary – 201500002185 – Unit block of Skippers Ct – 05/24 at 3pm to 05/26 at 10:45pm: After removing the screen, the home was entered through an unlocked rear window. Nothing appeared to have been stolen from the home.

Shooting – 201500002186 – 1700 block of Belle Dr – 05/27 at 12:08am: Officers responded to reports of shots fired in the area. They located a 22 year old man from Annapolis suffering from two gun shot wounds to his extremities. He was transported to Baltimore Shock Trauma for treatment.
