

Daily Report 11/09/15

In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 305 calls for service and arrested 22 people.

Theft of a Trailer – 201500005132 – 1800 block of George Av – 11/05 at 5pm to 11/06 at 10am: A black 7' X 14' flat bed trailer, MD reg. 114564X, was stolen.

Theft from Vehicle – 201500005137 – 200 block of Farragut Ct – 11/05 at 5pm to 11/06 at 10am: A parking permit was stolen from an unlocked vehicle.

Handgun Violation – 201500005142 – Unit block of Pleasant St – 11/06 at 8:54pm: Officers were in the area when they heard a gun shot and saw a man fleeing from a vehicle. Officers chased the man, later identified as Marlon Green, 27, of Annapolis. Officers caught up to Green as he was trying to scale a fence and found a handgun that Green dropped on the other side of the fence. Green was arrested and transported to the police department. Green appeared to have a graze wound to his thigh. He was treated by paramedics for this minor injury at the police department. Officers believe Green accidentally discharged the handgun when he fled out of the vehicle. A spent bullet was found near the vehicle and the handgun recovered had an empty shell casing in the chamber. Codeine and Oxycodone pills were found in the vehicle and Green had \$1,728 in cash in his pockets. Green is a convicted felon and was charged with five counts relating to the gun and CDS possession. He is being held without bond at the Jennifer Road Detention Center.

Theft from Vehicle – 201500005153 – Unit block of Duke of Gloucester St – 11/07 from 12:05pm to 1:30pm: The rear passenger side window of the vehicle was shattered and a Michael Kors purse, three other purses, and a Garmin GPS unit were stolen.

Handgun Violations – 201500005157 – 700 block of Newtowne Dr – 11/07 at 7:55pm: Officers were in the area when a male, later identified as Jeremia Myers, 16, of Annapolis, started running from them towards the wooded area around the community. Myers was holding his waistband as he was running. Myers reached the fence and threw an object over it as officers caught up to him. Officers located a handgun on the other side of the fence. Myers admitted to possessing and throwing the handgun. Myers was charged as an adult with handgun on person and possession of a handgun by a minor.

Burglary – 201500005159 – 900 block of Berwick Dr – 11/07 at 9:25pm: Officers responded to the home for an intrusion alarm and discovered the rear door forced open and jewelry stolen.

Burglary – 201500005162 – 1200 block of Virginia St – 11/07 at 6:15pm to 11/08 at 7:30am: Jewelry was stolen after the home was apparently entered through an unlocked dog door.

Theft from Vehicle – 201500005163 – 700 block of Brannock Terrace – 11/08 from 10:30am to 12:12pm: An Apple iPhone 6 and a white iPod in a grey and yellow case were stolen from a vehicle left with the windows down.

The two suspects ran from the area after the robbery.
