

Daily Report 11/12/15

In the last 48 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 208 calls for service and arrested 14 people.

Shots Fired – 201500005192 – 1100 block of Madison St – 11/10 at 12:36pm: Officers responded to the area for several reports of shots fired. They located an adult male victim who told officers he was standing outside an apartment building when an unknown suspect began shooting at him. No one was struck and no property damaged.

Theft from Vehicle – 201500005195 – Americana Dr at Norman Dr – 11/11 from 1:45am to 2:10am: An observant citizen reported three subjects riding bicycles in the area looking into parked vehicles. Officers located a vehicle in the area with its interior lights on that appeared to have been entered. The owner confirmed that a DVD player was stolen from the vehicle, the DVD player was located on the side of one of the apartment buildings.

Theft from Vehicle – 201500005196 – 900 block of Spa Rd – 11/11 at 2:40am: An officer was flagged down by an observant citizen who saw three male suspects attempting to enter a parked vehicle. Officers found an unlocked vehicle with the passenger door open. The vehicle's owner could not be located, so it is unknown if anything was stolen. On 11/11 at 8:45am the owner of another vehicle that had been parked in the same area reported that a Garmin Nuvi GPS unit and a checkbook were stolen out of his unlocked vehicle overnight.

Thefts from Vehicles – 201500005198, 5200, 5210, 5211 – 300 block of Melvin Av, 100 and 400 block of Giddings Av, and Unit block of Annapolis St – 11/10 at 10pm to 11/11 at 7am: A Dell laptop, white 64GB Apple iPod, 20GB Apple iPod Classic, and an Apple iPod Touch were stolen from four unlocked vehicles. A bag was stolen from another unlocked vehicle, but was found abandoned in the 100 block of Shiley St.

Handgun Violations – 201500005213 – 1400 block of Tyler Av – 11/11 at 1:40pm: Officers were in the area when they saw a man later identified as Antonio Crump, 18, of Washington DC. Crump was standing on the sidewalk near the playground holding an open bottle of beer. Officers starting talking with Crump and he provided them with a false name. Crump tried run away from the officers, but they were able to handcuff him. Officers found Crump had a loaded handgun in his jacket pocket. Crump also had a metal grinder, used for preparing marijuana to smoke, and a vial of PCP in other pockets. The handgun was reported stolen from Newport News, Virginia. Crump gave officers his real name and they found he had an open warrant for armed robbery and possession of a handgun. Crump was arrested and charged with 17 criminal counts. He is currently being held at the Jennifer Road Detention on \$75,000 in these charges.

Burglary – 201500005224 – 900 block of Windwhisper La – 11/11 at 8:10pm: An observant citizen reported a possible burglary in progress at a neighbor's home. Officers arrived and found the front door to the home forced open, but no one inside. Money was stolen from the home.
