December 8, and 15 – Cocoa with a Cop at Midnight Madness from 6pm to 9pm on Main Street at Church Circle – Enjoy a free cup of hot chocolate with your local police officers

In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 332 calls for service and arrested 17 people.

The three began arguing and the two suspects assaulted the victim. One of the suspects had a small knife and cut the victim. The two suspects fled the area on foot. Submitting Anonymous Tips to Metro Crime Stoppers of Maryland

Metro Crime Stoppers of Maryland is an organization separate from the Annapolis Police Department. When you text, phone in, or submit your Annapolis crime tip online Metro Crime Stoppers receives your tip anonymously and only forwards your tip information to the Annapolis Police Department. No identifying information is ever forwarded to us. Please be assured that only your tip is communicated from Metro Crime

Stoppers to the police department, not any identifying information about you. Metro Crime Stoppers uses a special coding system to protect your identity, they do not use Caller ID or record telephone conversations. If your tip leads to the arrest or indictment of a person for a felony you could qualify for up to a \$2,000 cash reward from Metro Crime Stoppers.
