

## 2/3/17 – APD Daily Report

**In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 96 calls for service and arrested 11 people.**

**Stolen and Recovered Vehicle** – 201700000478 – 1100 block of Cove Rd – 02/02 at 7:40am: A 2015 Hyundai was stolen when it was left unlocked with the engine running and the key in the ignition. Later the same day officers recovered the vehicle parked and unoccupied in the 1200 block of Madison St.

**Burglary** – 201700000479 – 200 block of Chatham La – 01/31 at 8pm to 02/02 at 11am: The home's unlocked garage was entered, but nothing appeared to be stolen.

**Theft from Vehicle** – 201700000481 – 200 block of Chatham La – 02/01 at 6pm to 02/02 at 12pm: A black backpack was stolen from an unlocked vehicle.

**Shooting** – 201700000484 – 1100 block of Frederick Douglass St – 02/02 at 5pm: Officers responded to the area with the fire department for an unknown problem. Upon arrival they were flagged down by a citizen who reported that someone had been shot. The victim, Terrance Hicks, 38, of Annapolis, was located with non-life threatening injuries. He was transported to an area hospital. Detectives determined that Hicks was outside in the area when he was shot by Trey Thorpe, 31, of Baltimore. Detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Thorpe for attempted first degree murder and related charges. On 02/03 Thorpe was located and arrested in the 100 block Brightwater Dr. He is awaiting his initial appearance before the District Court Commissioner.

**Attempted Thefts from Vehicles** – 201700000488 – 1100 block of August Dr - 02/02 at 9:40pm: An observant caller reported seeing two male suspects walking through the parking lot checking vehicle door handles. They did not enter any of the vehicles because they were all locked. Officers checked the area but did not locate the suspects.

When you text, phone in, or submit your Annapolis crime tip online Metro Crime Stoppers receives your tip anonymously and only forwards your tip information to the Annapolis Police Department. No identifying information is ever forwarded to us. Please be assured that only your tip is communicated from Metro Crime Stoppers to the police department, not any identifying information about you. Metro Crime Stoppers uses a special coding system to protect your identity, they do not use Caller ID or record telephone conversations. If your tip leads to the arrest or indictment of a person for a felony you could qualify for up to a \$2,000 cash reward from Metro Crime Stoppers.
