

## Annapolis Police Department Daily Report 02/13/17

### Community Events

February 14 at 6:30pm – Neighborhood Safety Meeting – at 199 Taylor Av

**In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 303 calls for service and arrested 18 people.**

**Theft from Vehicle** – 201700000616 – Unit block of Horn Point Ct – 02/08 from 1am to 1:15am: Clothing was stolen from an unlocked vehicle.

**Attempted Theft from Vehicle** – 201700000618 – Unit block of Eastern Av - 02/09 from 1am to 1:30am: Video surveillance from a home security system showed two suspects trying vehicle door handles. Because the vehicles were locked they were not entered.

**Stabbing** – 201700000623 – Newman St at Compromise St – 02/11 at 1:30am: On 02/11 at 2:50am officers responded to the Anne Arundel Medical Center for a report of a stabbing that occurred earlier. The adult male victim reported that he was walking in the area of Newman St when a fight broke out around him. He was struck while trying to walk through the fight and did not realize that he had been stabbed in the shoulder. The injury is not life threatening.

**Burglary** – 201700000624 – 1500 block of West St – 02/10 at 8pm to 02/11 at 12:45am:

After entering the home through an unlocked door money, an Asus laptop computer, Skull Candy headphones, and a Samsung TV were stolen.

**Assault** – 201700000636 – 600 block of Greenbriar La – 02/12 at 3:30am: The adult male victim reported that he and a friend got into a physical altercation. He reported that Carlos Lemus Mejia, 23, of Annapolis charged him with a knife.

Lemus Mejia then struck the victim in the head with a beer bottle. The victim was cut in the head and hand. Officers discovered Lemus Mejia in the area, when they approached him he grabbed a wooden stake from a cardboard sign posted into the ground and approached the officers with the stake raised up. Lemus Mejia complied with orders to the drop the stake and was arrested without further incident. Lemus Mejia was arrested and charged with first degree assault, two counts of second degree assault, and reckless endangerment. He is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention. The victim was treated for his injuries at the scene.

**Stolen Vehicle** – 201700000638 – 700 block of Glendon Av – 02/11 at 10pm to 02/12 at 9am: A black 2002 Toyota RAV4, MD reg. 1CJ6402, was stolen. The owner believes the vehicle may have been left unlocked with a spare key inside.

**Theft from Vehicle** – 201700000642 – Unit block of State Circle – 02/12 from 9:30pm to 10:30pm: The vehicle's window was smashed and a blue duffel bag left on the rear seats of the vehicle was stolen.
