February 14 at 6:30pm – Neighborhood Safety Meeting – at 199 Taylor Av

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 91 calls for service and arrested 5 people.

Theft from Vehicle - 201700000649 - Unit block of Boucher Av - 02/08 at 9pm to 02/09 at 6am: An Apple iPhone 5c, Oakley sunglasses, a headlamp, and a Garmin Forerunner fitness watch were stolen from an unlocked vehicle.

Theft from Vehicle - 201700000650 - Unit block of Spa Creek Landing - 02/12 at 9pm to 02/13 at 9am: A window to the vehicle was smashed and a Michael Kors wallet was stolen from inside.

Stabbing - 201700000654 - 1800 block of Bowman Ct - 02/13 at 8pm: The adult female victim reported that she and Willie Smith, 38, of Annapolis were in a home together when he became angry. Smith assaulted the woman and a juvenile female. Smith pursued the juvenile with two knives and attempted to stab her. The adult female and juvenile female attempted to disarm Smith and suffered cuts on their fingers. Officers arrived and arrested Smith. Smith will be charged with first and second degree assault and reckless endangerment. Smith is awaiting his initial hearing before the District Court Commissioner. The two victims had minor injuries and were treated on scene.
