

Annapolis Police Department Daily Report 02/15/17

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 92 calls for service and arrested 6 people.

Good News – On 02/14 the APD Flex Unit with the Maryland State Police Gang Enforcement Unit conducted an operation under the Safe Streets Initiative. At 7:40pm members of the task force observed Bdotshee Wells, 23, and Carlos Wallace, 16, both of Annapolis traveling together to complete a drug deal. The vehicle they were in was stopped by officers in the 1900 block of West St. Wells fled from the vehicle, was arrested and two half gram bags of suspected heroin were in his possession. Wells was charged with possession of CDS with the intent to distribute and possession of CDS. He is being held on \$25,000 bond at the Jennifer Road Detention Center. Wells also had an active warrant for violation of probation in a CDS distribution case. Wallace remained in the vehicle and officers found that he had a loaded handgun in his possession. Wallace was charged as an adult with seven criminal charges related to possession of a handgun and CDS violations. He is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center on \$3,000 bond.



There are no preventable Part One offenses to report this morning. Part One offenses are those incidents we report to the MD State Police and the F.B.I. These incidents include homicides, robberies, burglaries, rapes, serious assaults, and thefts.
