April 30 – Annapolis Police Kids Club at 5:30pm at Bayhawks Lacrosse

In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 319 calls for service and arrested 11 people.

Armed Robbery – 201600001517 – 1900 block of West St – 04/16 at 2:30am: Two adult male suspects entered the business and approached the adult male employee. One of the suspects displayed a handgun and demanded money. Both suspects fled the business after taking money.

Shots Fired – 201600001532 – President St at Park Av – 04/17 at 4:11am: Officers responded for reports of shots fired in the area. Officers arrived and did not locate any suspects or victims struck by gunfire in the area. Three homes and nine vehicles were struck by gunfire. No injuries were reported.
