In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 98 calls for service and arrested 8 people.

Good News – On 04/27 Donte Mitchell, 36, of Annapolis was arrested for assaulting and threatening an adult female victim with a knife on 04/25 in an apartment in the unit block of West Washington St. The victim reported that Mitchell grabbed her hair and arm and demanded her cell phone. When she refused, he pulled out a 6” pocket knife and threatened her with it. Mitchell took the cell phone and the victim was able to flee the apartment and call the police. Mitchell fled the area before officers arrived. He was located on 04/27 and arrested. Mitchell is charged with armed robbery, robbery, second degree assault, and possession of a dangerous weapon with intent to injure. He is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center without bond.

Armed Robbery – 201600001699 – Unit block of Silopanna Rd – 04/27 at 5:50pm: The adult male victim was exiting his vehicle when he was approached by two male suspects, one holding a knife, the other, a handgun. The suspect with the knife demanded money from the victim. They took money and fled the area in a green vehicle.
