In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 293 calls for service and arrested 13 people.

Burglary – 201600003438 – 100 block of Lafayette Av – 08/05 from 12:01am to 7:20am: An unlocked window was entered and money and a 50” flat screen television were stolen. Two vehicles’ keys were also taken from the home, but were found inside the parked vehicles. Nothing was stolen from the vehicles.

Attempted Theft from Vehicle – 201600003450 – Unit block of Northwest St – 08/05 at 6:30pm to 08/06 at 4:35am: The driver’s side window was smashed and convertible top cut, but nothing was stolen from the vehicle.

Burglary and Auto Theft – 201600003452 – 1300 block of Tyler Av – 08/05 at 11pm to 08/06 at 8:30am: The victim reported that his home was broken into and his vehicle keys were stolen. The vehicle was also taken. Maryland State Police located the vehicle with Chela Tucker, 29, of Glen Burnie inside. Tucker is a relative of the victim and the victim confirmed Tucker did not have permission to enter his home or take his vehicle. Tucker was arrested and charged with first, third, and fourth degree burglary, motor vehicle theft, and theft.

Attempted Theft from Vehicle – 201600003454 – 900 block of Langdon Ct – 08/06 at 2:30am: An unknown suspect attempted to enter a locked vehicle and then entered an unlocked vehicle in the same area. Nothing was stolen from either vehicle.

Theft from Vehicle – 201600003455 – 100 block of Charles St – 08/05 at 5pm to 08/06 at 12:30pm: A package left on the back seat of a soft top Jeep Wrangler was stolen after the window was unzipped.

Attempted Theft from Vehicle – 201600003457 – 900 block of Berwick Dr – 08/05 at 5pm to 08/06 at 12pm: An unlocked vehicle was entered but nothing was stolen.

Theft from Vehicle – 201600003464 – 200 block of West St – 08/06 at 11:45am to 08/07 at 6:20am: The vehicle’s window was smashed and a pair of Turtle Beach headphones and a Sony Playstation 4 game console were stolen.

Officers located him and arrested him for fourth degree burglary and trespassing. Lewis was searched incident to arrest

and property was found on him from a theft from vehicle in the unit block of Dean St on 07/11. Lewis was also charged with the theft from vehicle.

Burglary – 201600003467 – 100 block of Lafayette Av – 08/06 at 11pm to 08/07 at 11am: A window was entered and a vehicle key and 46” flat screen television were stolen from the home.

Burglary – 201600003468 – 700 block of Genessee St – 08/06 at 6:45pm to 08/07 at 10:45am: A red and black Fuji Aloha triathlon style bicycle was stolen from an open garage.

Shooting – 201600003479 – 1400 block of Tyler Av – 08/07 at 10:30pm: Officers responded to the area for reports of shots fired and located a 20 year female who was shot. The victim was the passenger in a vehicle. Three other unoccupied vehicles were struck by gun fire. The victim was transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center with non-life threatening injuries. Submitting Anonymous Tips to Metro Crime Stoppers of Maryland

Metro Crime Stoppers of Maryland is an organization separate from the Annapolis Police Department. When you text, phone in, or submit your Annapolis crime tip online Metro Crime Stoppers receives your tip anonymously and only forwards your tip information to the Annapolis Police Department. No identifying information is ever forwarded to us. Please be assured that only your tip is communicated from Metro Crime Stoppers to the police department, not any identifying information about you. Metro Crime Stoppers uses a special coding system to protect your identity, they do not use Caller ID or record telephone conversations. If your tip leads to the arrest or indictment of a person for a felony you could qualify for up to a \$2,000 cash reward from Metro Crime Stoppers.
