Community Events

February 9 – Neighborhood Safety Meeting from 6:30pm to 8pm at 199 Taylor Avenue

In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 276 calls for service and arrested 20 people.

Stabbing – 201600000375 – 300 block of Atwater Dr – 01/29 at 1:25pm: Officers responded to the 500 block of Annapolitan La for a report of a stabbing. Officers located Zykia Mitchell, 17, of Annapolis suffering from stab wounds to her head and neck. Through investigation detectives learned that Mitchell and Ariel Anderson, 16, of Annapolis both had knives during a fight that occurred outside in the 300 block of Atwater Dr. Anderson had a small cut under her eye and was treated on scene. Anderson was arrested and charged as an adult with first and second degree assault, reckless endangerment, concealing a dangerous weapon and possession of a dangerous weapon with intent to injure. Anderson was released after posting \$50,000 bond. Mitchell was transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center for treatment. Detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Mitchell charging her as an adult. Mitchell was arrested on this warrant on 01/30 and charged with first and second degree assault, reckless endangerment, and possession of a dangerous weapon with intent to injure. Mitchell was released after posting \$250,000 bond.

Burglary – 201600000376 – 800 block of Betsy Ct – 01/29 at 1:35pm: The Assistant Property Manager reported that a vacant, boarded up unit appeared to have been broken into. Officers arrived and found Mary Linkous, 28, of Harwood asleep inside the residence. Linkous was arrested and charged with fourth degree burglary. She was released on her own recognizance by the District Court Commissioner.

Homicide – 201600000391 – 700 block of Newtowne Dr – 01/30 at 6:46pm: Officers responded to the area for a report of a man who had been shot. Upon arrival officers located Jordan Davis, 20, of Baltimore. Davis had been shot in the neck. Davis was transported to Anne Arundel Medical Center and died from his injuries. Burglary – 201600000400 – Unit block of West St – 01/31 at 3:24am: Officers responded to the business for an intrusion alarm and found a ladder propped up to the second storey of the building and a window forced open. It does not appear any entry into the building was made.

Theft from Vehicle – 201600000403 – 1000 block of Wells Av – 01/23 at 5pm to 01/31 at 10am: A 500 watt Homelite generator was stolen from the open rear bed of a pick up truck.

Burglary – 201600000412 – 1800 block of Copeland St – 02/01 at 12:20am: Officers responded for a report of a man banging on the caller's door. While en route, the man kicked open the door and entered the home. Officers arrived and located Todd Thomas, 31, of Annapolis exiting the home. Thomas was arrested and, when searched, officers found seven

small bags of suspected heroin. Thomas was charged with third and fourth degree burglary, destruction of property, and possession of CDS with intent to distribute. Thomas is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center on a temporary commitment pending his initial hearing pending his initial hearing before the District Court Commissioner.
