## Community Events

**In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 284 calls for service and arrested 14 people.**

**UPDATE Critically Missing Person** – 201600000359 – 1200 block of Barbud La – 01/27 at 8am: On 01/28 Michael Taylor, 32, of Annapolis was reported missing. On 02/06 Hamblen County Sheriff's Department in Tennessee reported that they recovered Michael Taylor's deceased body on 02/02. Mr. Taylor's death is not believed to be as a result of a criminal act.

**UPDATE Homicide** – 201600000391 – 700 block of Newtowne Dr – 01/30 at 6:46pm: On 01/30 officers responded for a report of a man who had been shot. Upon arrival officers located Jordan Davis, 20, of Baltimore. Davis had been shot in the neck. Davis was transported to Anne Arundel Medical Center and died from his injuries. On 02/05 Carlos Simms, 20, of Annapolis was arrested for the murder of Jordan Davis. Simms was charged with first and second degree murder and thirteen other related charges. Simms is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center without bond.
