April 12 – Neighborhood Safety Meeting at 6:30pm at 199 Taylor Av

In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 80 calls for service and arrested 4 people.

Upon our arrival, they found silver Infiniti that had left the roadway, struck a tree, and came to rest on its side. One of the two occupants was flown to Shock Trauma, and the other was deceased at the scene. Investigation is ongoing.
