

Daily Report 05/02/16

In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 245 calls for service and arrested 10 people.

Good News – On 04/29 two men were arrested for possession with intent to distribute illegal drugs. At 11:40pm an observant officer in the 100 block of Compromise St noticed two men, who appeared to be working in the area, enter a parked van. The officer approached the van and when he looked inside he saw a scale, with suspected powdered cocaine on top, balanced on the center console of the vehicle, between the two men. The officer made contact with the men and they were identified as Jerrod Cox, 29, of Henderson and Antonio Herold, 22, of Annapolis. The suspected cocaine on the scale had an approximate weight of 4.7 grams. Officers discovered an additional 1.3 grams of suspected cocaine in Cox's pocket. Inside the vehicle, officers discovered 62 grams of suspected marijuana, two glass smoking pipes, and a further 5.4 grams of cocaine. Cox and Herold were arrested and each was charged with six counts relating to CDS possession with intent to distribute and CDS possession. Cox was released from the District Court Commissioner on \$30,000 bond. Herold was released from the District Court Commissioner on \$10,000 bond.

Burglary – 201600001725 – 1400 block of Tyler Av – 04/28 from 8am to 9pm: A locked office door within the unlocked community center was forced open. Property was damaged or destroyed, but it did not appear anything was stolen.

Shots Fired – 201600001743 – Unit block of Juliana Circle – 04/30 at 10:30pm: Officers responded to the area for reports of shots fired. Officers discovered that two homes on Juliana Circle were struck by gun fire. No one was injured.

Burglary – 201600001747 – 1100 block of August Dr – 04/30 at 7pm to 05/01 at 1am: The front door to the home was forced open and a handgun, jewelry, and a Dell laptop computer were stolen.

Stolen Vehicle – 201600001748 – 100 block of Victor Parkway – 04/30 at 8pm to 05/01 at 8:30am: A blue 1995 Ford F150 pick up truck, MD reg. 6CE4315, with Neal Concrete printed on the doors was stolen after it was left unlocked with the keys inside.

Burglary – 201600001752 – Unit block of Spindrift Way – 04/30 at 7pm to 05/01 at 4:40pm: The front door to the home was forced open and money and a TV were stolen.
