June 11 – Annapolis Police Kids Club – Trip to Glenn L. Martin Maryland Aviation Museum

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 110 calls for service and arrested 8 people.

Theft of Bicycle – 201600002081 – 100 block of Jefferson St – 05/21 from 2pm to 5pm: A red Schwinn men’s mountain bicycle with a chain on the seat post and a black storage bag on the down tube was stolen when it was left unsecured.

Burglary – 201600002109 – 100 block of Bertina Nick Way – 05/23 at 12:25pm: Reginald King, 25, of Annapolis was arrested when he kicked open the front door of an adult female acquaintance’s home. Once inside the home he pushed and shoved the woman and broke three plates. King fled before officers arrived, but officers quickly located him near by. King was arrested and charged with third and fourth degree burglary, second degree assault, and destruction of property. King is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center on \$250,000 bond.

Stabbing – 201600002128 – Unit block of Hicks Av – 05/24 at 4:46pm: Kendall Jones, 24, of Annapolis was arrested after stabbing an adult male acquaintance. The victim suffered minor injuries to his hand. Jones fled, but officers located and arrested her near by. Jones was charged with first and second degree assault and reckless endangerment. She is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center on \$15,000 bond.
