Community Events

June 11 – Annapolis Police Kids Club – Trip to Glenn L. Martin Maryland Aviation Museum

In the last 96 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 422 calls for service and arrested 26 people.

Assault – 201600002186 – 100 block of Brightwater Dr – 05/27 at 9:45pm: Two adult men were standing outside when a vehicle drove by and the occupants fired a paintball gun and struck both men several times.

Burglary – 201600002189 – 1000 block of Timber Creek Dr – 05/27 from 9am to 11:20pm: The front door to the home was forced open and a Nexus tablet computer, a Zoppini wristwatch, and Nikon cameras were stolen.
