In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 281 calls for service and arrested 24 people.

Armed Robbery – 201300003618 – 1200 block of West St – 08/02 at 7:40am: A man entered the gas station and asked for a pack of cigarettes. He produced a handgun, threatened the employee, and demanded money and cigarettes. The man left on foot with money and 53 packs of Newport cigarettes, also taking the employee's purse. The suspect is described as an African American male 30 to 50 years old, 5'11", 180 lbs, with a goatee. He was last seen wearing a black baseball cap, red short sleeve polo shirt, blue jeans, and tennis shoes.
