In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 96 calls for service and arrested 15 people.

Stolen & Recovered Vehicle – 201300005927 – 1800 block of Copeland St – 12/04 at 7:30am: A Lincoln Continental Mark IV was stolen from the 1800 block of Copeland St when the owner left the vehicle unlocked with the engine running and the key in the ignition. On 12/04 at 12:45pm Officers responded to the unit block of Chelsea Ct for a report a vehicle parking and the driver walking into the woods towards the 1400 block of Tyler Av. The vehicle was identified as the stolen Lincoln and the driver was located in the 1300 block of Tyler Av. The driver, Lamont Crouner, 20, of Annapolis was arrested and charged with motor vehicle unlawful taking, theft from \$10,000 to \$100,000, and unauthorized removal of property. He was released by the District Court Commissioner.

Armed Robbery – 201300005950 – 100 block of Obery Ct – 12/05 at 2am: A woman reported she was threatened by her estranged husband. He struck her in the face and threatened to stab her with a knife he was holding unless she gave him her car keys. She gave him the keys and he left the area in her vehicle. The vehicle is a white 1986 Cadillac Fleetwood, Maryland registration 37180Z.
