

Daily Report 04/23/13

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 98 calls for service and arrested 6 people.

Good News – On 04/22 Annapolis Police Officers arrested Domekio Blackwell, 24, of North Carolina for burglary to two homes in Annapolis. At 5pm a resident of the 100 block of Melvin Av discovered a burglary in which a PlayStation game console and other items were taken. Officers recognized some of the items taken from an earlier encounter with Blackwell on Ridgely Av. At that time Blackwell claimed the items were his. Officers tried to locate Blackwell, but were unsuccessful. Later officers received a call for a subject matching Blackwell's description soliciting door to door on Wardour Dr. Officers kept searching the area and finally located Blackwell in the 600 block of Taylor Av. Blackwell had items in his possession taken from an unreported burglary in the 200 block of Wardour Dr. Blackwell was arrested and charged with two counts of first and third degree burglary, four counts of theft over \$1,000, four counts of theft under \$1,000, two counts of trespassing, and soliciting in the city without a license. He is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center on \$250,000 bond.

Burglary – 201300001794 – 7000 block of Bay Front Dr – 04/20 from 1:20am to 1:40am: A glass door to the facility was kicked in and another interior door was also forced open, but nothing appears to be missing at this time.
