

Daily Report 07/22/14

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 100 calls for service and arrested 14 people.

Theft of Bicycles – 201400003619 – Unit block of Southgate Av – 07/20 from 9:30am to 12:30pm: A black men's Raleigh Technium road bicycle with white tape on the handlebars and a black men's mountain bicycle with bright yellow wheel rims were stolen from the front porch of a home.

Theft from Vehicle – 201400003630 – 900 block of Wells Av – 07/18 at 10pm to 07/19 at 5am: An orange Home Depot bucket containing hand tools and a DeWalt cordless drill in a black case were stolen from the bed of a pick up truck.
