

Daily Report 10/13/14

In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 313 calls for service and arrested 23 people.

Theft from Vehicle – 201400005094 – Unit block of Chelsea Ct – 10/09 at 9:30pm to 10/10 at 7am: A Garmin Nuvi GPS unit was stolen from an unlocked vehicle.

Shooting – 201400005109 – 1400 block of Tyler Av – 10/10 at 11:48pm: Officers responded for several calls reporting shots heard and, despite checking the area on foot, did not locate a victim, crime scene, or witnesses. On 10/11 at 12:45am Anne Arundel Medical Center notified the Annapolis Police Department that a 17 year old male from Annapolis arrived at the hospital with a gun shot wound to his leg. The juvenile said he was shot in the 1400 block of Tyler Avenue.
