

Daily Report 10/20/14

In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 305 calls for service and arrested 27 people.

Good News – On 10/17 at 8:22pm Officers from the Annapolis Police Department recovered a stolen vehicle and arrested the 15 year old male driving the vehicle. On 10/17 at 12:17pm officers responded to the 1100 block of West St for a report a stolen 2014 Toyota Highlander. The vehicle was stolen between 10/16 at 9pm and 10/17 at 9am after the keys were stolen from inside a business. At 8:22pm the same day an officer saw the vehicle being driven in the 1100 block of President St. The officer followed the vehicle onto Spa Creek Landing where the vehicle pulled into a parking spot. The driver and sole occupant ran out of the vehicle and was stopped by officers. The driver was identified as a 15 year old male from Annapolis. He was charged with motor vehicle theft and driving without a license and released to a guardian.

More Good News – On 10/18 Officers and Explorers from the Annapolis Police Department and Officers from Anne Arundel Community College Department of Public Safety and Police worked to raise \$2,778 for Special Olympics Maryland. Red Robin Restaurant at the Annapolis Mall hosted the Tip-A-Cop event, which saw officers waiting tables for “tip” donations. A big thank you goes out to everyone who donated, Red Robin, and the officers and Special Olympic athletes who came out for the event.

Armed Robbery – 201400005236 – 500 block of South Cherry Grove Av – 10/17 at 9:35pm: The adult male victim was smoking a cigarette in the area when an adult male approached him and asked for a cigarette. Then the suspect pointed a gun at the victim and demanded property. The suspect took a Verizon cell phone, a black wallet, and keys from the victim and fled on foot towards Forest Dr.

Burglary – 201400005246 – 1300 block of Tyler Av – 10/18 at 6:21pm: The adult female homeowner was home when she heard noises downstairs. She went downstairs and discovered three 8 to 10 year old juvenile males in the kitchen eating her food. All but one of the juveniles ran out of the home. One 9 year old boy from Annapolis remained on scene and spoke to officers. The homeowner did not want the juvenile charged at this time.

Burglary – 201400005248 – 900 block of Central St – 10/18 from 9:45pm to 10:15pm: The adult male resident returned home to find an acquaintance, Kyle Murray, 21, of Annapolis inside. Murray did not have permission to be inside the home and assaulted the resident as he fled the home. Officers arrived and could not locate Murray, but obtained a warrant for his arrest.
