

Daily Report 10/22/14

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 91 calls for service and arrested 6 people.

Good News – On 10/21 officers from the Annapolis Police Department arrested a 16 year old male from Annapolis for operating an unregistered dirt bike, driving without a license, and numerous traffic violations. Officers were in the area of Forest Dr when they saw a juvenile they knew operating a dirt bike on the sidewalk. The dirt bike displayed no registration plates and the operator was not wearing a helmet. Officers observed the dirt bike operator commit several traffic violations in different areas of the city and arrested him when they found him walking near Old Solomons Island Rd and Forest Dr. The juvenile was charged on a citation and released to a guardian.

Stolen Vehicle – 201400005283 – 1200 block of Ashton Ct – 10/20 at 6:45pm to 10/21 at 8am: The victim left her vehicle keys in the laundry room and when she returned they had been stolen. When she went out to her vehicle the next morning it had been stolen. The stolen vehicle is a dark blue 2010 Honda Civic four door sedan, MD reg. 1BN9019.

Burglary – 201400005288 – 2000 block of Forest Dr – 10/21 from 11:45am to 12pm: A resident was home when she heard the unlocked front door open and assumed it was a roommate. Later it was discovered that a large jar containing \$800 in quarters was stolen from a roommate's bedroom.

Assault – 201400005295 – 1200 block of Ashton Ct – 10/21 at 8pm: The adult male victim was outside when he was assaulted by a group of unknown subjects. One of the subjects struck him multiple times with possibly a baseball bat. The victim had several abrasions and lacerations to his head and was transported to Anne Arundel Medical Center.
