

Daily Report 10/27/14

In the last 72 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 332 calls for service and arrested 16 people.

Good News – On 10/25 officers from the Annapolis Police Department arrested Scotty Moss, 22, of Annapolis and issued him 20 traffic citations, including operating an unregistered dirt bike and driving while suspended. During the evening hours of 10/25 multiple calls were received for subjects operating dirt bikes illegally on the roadways. At 8:45pm Officers saw two dirt bikes turn onto Tyler Av and enter the Robinwood community where they were observed riding on sidewalks and through yards. The dirt bikes left the community and crossed the fields at Annapolis Middle School. One of the dirt bikes stalled and the operator, Scotty Moss, abandoned the dirt bike and fled on foot. Officers arrested Moss and recovered the dirt bike. Moss was also previously banned from Housing Authority property and was charged with trespassing. The other dirt bike was last seen leaving Annapolis and entering Anne Arundel County.

Stolen/Recovered Vehicle – 201400005340 – 1100 block of West St – 10/23 at 9pm to 10/24 at 9:50am: On 10/24 at 1:13pm Anne Arundel County Police Officers recovered a stolen 2006 Toyota Highlander that had not been reported yet. The vehicle was parked unlocked with a key inside when it was stolen. Anne Arundel County Police arrested a 17 year old male from Annapolis and charged him with the theft.
