

Daily Report 08/20/14

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 111 calls for service and arrested 15 people.

Good News – On 08/19 officers from NET patrolling Eastport made a vehicle stop and seized 110 grams of marijuana. At 8:30pm officers stopped a vehicle at President St and Madison St for driving without illuminated headlights. On approaching the vehicle they immediately smelled the odor of marijuana. The driver, Carl Milliken, 27, of Crownsville was found to have a suspended license. When the passenger, Paige Warren, 22, of Odenton exited the vehicle officers saw a clear plastic bag containing marijuana inside the vehicle. Milliken and Warren were charged with possession of marijuana. Both were released by the District Court Commissioner. A total of \$3,641 in cash was also seized for forfeiture from the pair.
