

Daily Report 8/26/14

In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 94 calls for service and arrested 11 people.

Attempted Theft of a Bicycle – 201400004279 – Unit block of Gentry Ct – 08/25 at 1:30 am: A citizen observed three juveniles attempt to steal his bicycle from his backyard. The citizen chased the juveniles onto Spa Rd where he lost sight of the juveniles. Officers responded to the area and conducted a perimeter search locating one of the juveniles that attempted to steal the bicycle. The juvenile, a 16 year old from Annapolis, was arrested for theft and released to his parents.

Theft of a Bicycle – 201400004283 – 1700 block of Belle Dr – 8/24 at 10:00 pm and 8/25 at 10:00 am: A blue Huffy Mountain bike was taken from the backyard of a residence. The bicycle was later located abandoned behind a building on Belle Dr.

Theft from Vehicle – 201400004284 – 200 block S. Cherry Grove - 8/24 at 6:30 pm and 8/25 at 12:30 pm: A Garmin gps was taken from an unlocked vehicle.
