

Daily Report 11/12/14

In the last 48 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 178 calls for service and arrested 12 people.

Shooting – 201400005581 – 1100 block of Madison St – 11/11 at 2:30am: Annapolis Police Dispatch received a call from Anne Arundel Medical Center reporting an adult male victim with a gunshot wound to his left pinky finger. The victim reported he was breaking up a fight between two adult males outside of one of the apartment buildings when he was shot. The victim was transported to Union Memorial Hospital where he was treated and released.

Burglary – 201400005574 – 800 block of Severn Av – 11/04 at 8am to 11/10 at 6:30pm: The home was entered through an open ground floor window and money was stolen.

Burglary and Attempted Robbery – 201400005593 – 900 block of Central St - 11/12 at 1:30am: Two adult suspects entered an unlocked home and confronted the sleeping adult male resident. The suspects demanded property and the victim struggled with them. The victim was stunned with a stun gun during the struggle. The suspects fled out of the home without taking anything. They were last seen running towards the dead end of Central St.
