In the last 24 hours Annapolis Police officers responded to 112 calls for service and arrested 13 people.

Update to Armed Robbery – 201400000568 – 1900 block of West St – 02/03 at 8:50pm: Two men entered the business displaying handguns. Both men were wearing masks and ordered the employees to get on the ground. The men took money and fled the business on foot. Both men are described as African American in their mid to late 20s. One is 5'9" to 6'0" tall, weighing 180 to 200 pounds. The other is 5'6" to 5'8" tall, weighing 150 to 170 pounds.
